

So what's special about the Weller Antique 107 Bourbon? Featuring a balanced and full-bodied flavor, this bronze-colored spirit ages for seven years in new white oak barrels. In Weller Antique 107, we detected notes of fruit, vanilla and cinnamon. The aroma hits your nose, with subtle hints of vanilla, caramel and butterscotch. Deeper within the nose are whiffs of leather and nutmeg with trace amounts of cinnamon. Most surprising is the amount of oak that comes off of it for a relatively young bourbon. The bottle has a \$150 value - tickets are \$15 each.
