Join us this Friday, September 12 at Maggiano's to welcome Sherry Boston, DeKalb County District Attorney. She stands among the elite in the world of prosecution as one of the rare 1% of African American females currently serving as district attorney nationwide. Ms. Boston was first elected as the district attorney for DeKalb County in 2016. In her capacity, DA Boston oversees the prosecution of felony offenses filed in the Superior Court of DeKalb County and supervises a staff of more than 300 people including attorneys, investigators, paralegals, victim advocates, and administrative professionals."
