Since Dan has been with ASC, it has hosted several prominent sporting events such as the NCAA Men's and Women's Final Four, MLB, NHL, and NBA All-Star Games, WrestleMania XXVII, and ACC and SEC Basketball Tournaments. Most recently, the ASC managed the effort to successfully recruit the 2018 College Football Playoff National Championship, Super Bowl LIII (2019), and the 2020 NCAA Men's Final Four. During his time at the ASC, the organization has been named Sports Commission of the Year by the National Association of Sports Commissions four times (2000, 2004, 2006, and 2015).

Corso is President of the Atlanta Football Host Committee Inc., for the 2018 College Football Playoff National Championship, and serves on the Board of Directors for the Atlanta Convention & Visitors Bureau and College Football Hall of Fame, and is on the Advisory Board for the Celebration Bowl.
