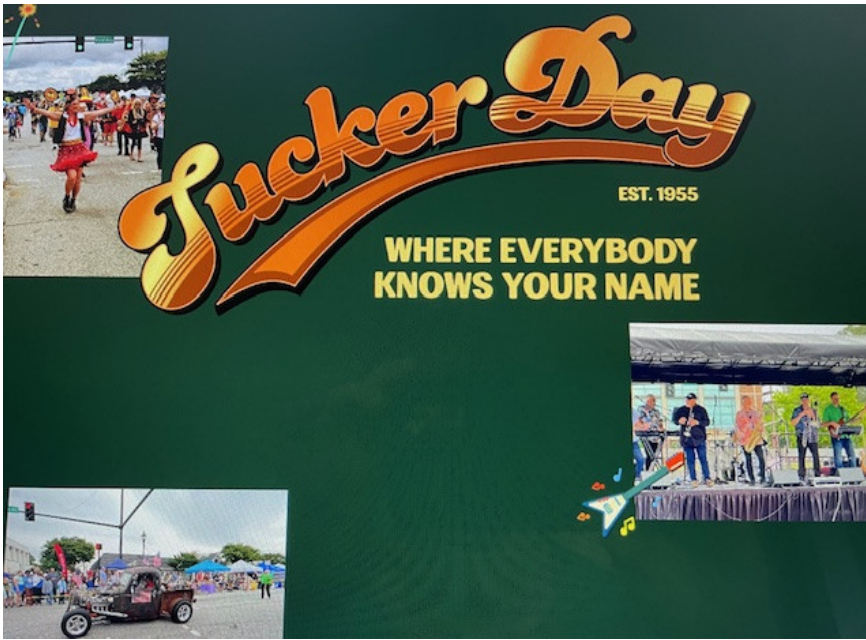

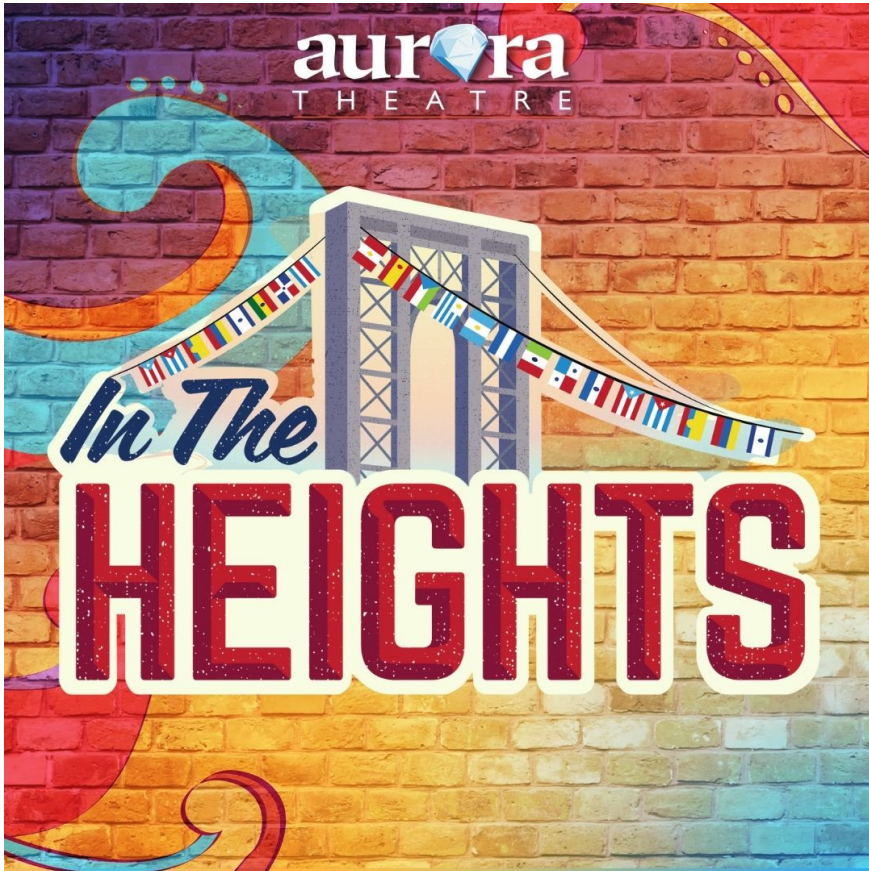
Help Us Fill Golfer Ditty Bags - May 13
